POLITICAL ACTION FUND COMMITTEE CONSTITUTION

Article I - Name

This organization shall be known as Los Rios College Federation of Teachers - Political Action Fund Committee (PAFC).

Article II - Purposes

The purposes of LRCFT PAFC are:

1. To support and strengthen the commitment of the citizens and the government to excellence in public education at all levels.
2. To promote and strive for the improvement of the public schools by encouraging and stimulating educators to take a more active part in governmental affairs pertaining to public education.
3. To encourage educators to know and understand the nature and actions of their government and the important political issues as they pertain to public education.
4. To assist educators in organizing themselves for more effective political action and in carrying out their civic responsibilities.
5. To engage in any suitable activities to achieve the purposes stated above.

LRCFT COPE CONSTITUTION

Article III - Committee

The affairs of this organization shall be managed by a Committee.

1. The Committee shall consist of:
 - a. The Executive Board of the Los Rios College Federation of Teachers, CFT, AFT, AFL-CIO; and
 - b. Other individuals, who volunteered and/or are appointees by the president of LRCFT.
1. The members of the Committee shall serve for a term of two years, which shall be concurrent with that of the term of LRCFT officers.
2. The chairperson of the Committee shall become a non-voting member of the LRCFT Executive Board and shall not be an elected member of the LRCFT Executive Board.

Article IV - Officers

The chairman and secretary-treasurer shall be elected by and from the Committees and shall serve for a term of two years.

Article V - Meetings

Meetings shall be scheduled as needed. At least two meetings a year shall be held.

Article VI - Parliamentary Authority and Procedure

Except as otherwise provided for in these bylaws, all meetings of LRCFT-COPE shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order, Revised.

Article VII - Amendments

Amendments to these bylaws may be made by a majority vote of the Committee not less than thirty (30) days following submission of the proposed amendments to the LRCFT Executive Board and upon ratification of LRCFT Executive Board.
