Memorandum of Understanding Between Los Rios Community College District And The Los Rios College Federation of Teachers

Salary Placement Pilot

Intent:

The LRCFT and LRCCD have the shared interest of hiring a strong faculty workforce. Experience in teaching, working in occupations that inform classroom practices, and clinical and/or occupational experience is central to that goal. The 2020-2023 contract currently places limits on the amount of experience that is counted in a new full-time faculty member's salary placement. The constraints have made retaining newly hired faculty in some fields difficult. The goal of this MOU is to pilot new placement criteria.

Agreement:

- 1. LRCFT and LRCCD agree that the maximum step placement for a new full-time faculty member is Step 8.
- 2. LRCFT and LRCCD agree to change the limit on accumulated part-time teaching from three (3) years to a maximum of eight (8) years of teaching experience.
 - a. PT teaching that occurred during summers will count towards the accumulated part-time teaching experience for initial step placement.
- 3. LRCFT and LRCCD agree to lift the limit on occupational experience from one (1) year to a maximum of eight(8) years.
 - Accumulated part-time occupational experience, converted to full-time equivalent, will count towards initial placement up to a maximum of eight (8) years.
 - b. The number of hours per week considered to be full-time shall be 36.
- 4. LRCFT and LRCCD agree to re-evaluate the step placement of faculty hired to teach beginning January 2021 or later
 - a. If applicable, faculty will be placed on the appropriate salary step relative to the agreements outlined in this MOU.
 - b. The faculty member's new step will be effective Fall Semester 2022.
 - c. There will be no retroactive payment for this new step placement.
- 5. This MOU will sunset in June 2023 unless LRCFT and LRCCD agree to incorporate this MOU into the collective bargaining agreement.
